I. Community Investment and Inclusion Fund (CIIF)



- **CE's 2001 Policy Address announced to set up \$300 Mn CIIF to promote social capital through collaborative partnerships across the community, business and public sectors**
- **CIIF launched in August 2002 to provide seed money to support community-initiated projects to promote community participation and mutual help at the local community level**



- **Health, Welfare & Food Bureau, assisted by District Social Welfare Officers of SWD, has been:**
 - **promoting the concept of tripartite partnership and corporate social responsibility through briefings in local communities and liaison with corporate funders;**
 - **rendering advice and support to facilitate matching and collaboration among community organizations and the business sector on project-basis**



- **CIIF has in the past two years served as a catalyst in mobilizing local resources and drawing together different sectors of the community to build up social capital**
- **A total of 59 projects from 4 batches of application have been selected, with funding amounting to around \$50 Mn**
